Milliken seeks renewable energy sources and pioneering applications to reduce its footprint. The opening of our second methane project brings the reduction of pollution emissions equivalent to 13,000 vehicles. Waste water



treatment biosolids have been used as a fuel source in our boilers since 1994. Our South Carolina hydroelectric plant, which emits zero carbon, provides 10% of company-wide electricity annually.

Milliken professionally managed forests sequester more carbon dioxide than our facilities emit worldwide. Our Trees for All™ initiative works to educate the supply chain and reduce greenhouse gases (GHG) impacts for the future.

Four decades of worldwide site-based environmental management system guarantee that we are beyond compliance in setting efficiency benchmarks at all locations. One outcome is a 22% global reduction in carbon emissions for Milliken & Company since 2005. Milliken is a recognized leader in reducing chemicals on the Clean Air Act Hazardous Air Pollutant List. An aggressive, voluntary program to reduce emissions resulted in a 98% reduction in CFC's (chlorofluorocarbons) starting in 1990.
